

We have received a high evaluation in the CSR audit conducted by Intertek.

The CSR audit was conducted by Intertek, an international certification body requested by our important customer, Dyson in England. The purpose of this audit is for Dyson to ensure that there are no violations of law or international standards on the supply chain in the filed of human rights, labor environment, health and safety, and environmental preservation.

Concerning the evaluation result, there is Grade A to Grade E, we have received a high evaluation of “Grade A: High Performance(87%)”, which means that there is no problem for Uchiya. In general, it is rare for a company to be evaluated as Grade A at a first audit. It is usual that a company start as Grade C and aim for a higher grade by making improvements over a period of a few years.

Our company has constantly worked on various activities and challenges. We have become a member of the United Nations Global Compact and have respected international codes of conduct. Concerning respect for human rights, we have made a “Healthy Company Declaration” to the Federation of Health Insurance Associations, and have been certified as a healthy excellent company, “Silver Certification”. And also, we have obtained “Certification of Senior Activity Promotion Declaration Company” from Saitama Prefecture. Because we have worked on many other activities and challenges, these achievements were highly evaluated.

The result of the audit would strengthen the business between Dyson and Uchiya in the future. We will observe the fundamental principles in human rights, labor, environment, and business ethics, and fulfill our social mission and responsibilities in the future.
